Notification Regarding "Suspension of Classes & Hostel Evacuation"

Attention: <u>Vice-Chancellor, Directors/Principals/Registrar/HODs of all Techno India Group</u>
<u>Schools/Colleges/University</u>

As the situation around the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to evolve, we are constantly monitoring the updates from the World Health Organization and Government agencies.

- 2. In view of the above, you are hereby requested to use **virtual learning platform along with** Online Classes from next week so that there is **minimum academic loss to the Students**. Details regarding the procedure and schedule of online classes will be guided by the Academic Coordinator or Head of the Institution of all TIG Schools/ Colleges/University/NBU CIS/TIG Skill Academy.
- 3. All Faculty and Staff Members of Techno India Group Campuses will continue to observe the normal working hours till further notice and all other activities related to **Admission**, **Fees Collection**, **Administration**, **projects and Maintenance related work will continue** as per work schedule of the Institute.
- **4.** All Colleges/School/University's hostel have to be vacated and circulate hostel evacuation notice by the Head of the Institution (also, you are hereby advised to make separate agreement at Hostel for foreign national, if any) from the forenoon of **15**th **March 2020** to till further instructions & all other activities pertaining to residential student at the Campus are 'Called Off' with effect from Monday, 16th March, 2020 up to 31st March, 2020 as a precautionary measure.
- 5. TIG Corporate will operate as business as usual with focus attention towards current developments

All TIG School, Colleges, University's Student related activities/events are cancelled until further notice.

You are advised to wait for the further guidelines pertaining to address the academic loss to the Students.

However, the Board and University Examinations would be held as per schedule.
